Friendly Reminders

Here are a few “housekeeping items” to keep in mind to help our year continue running smoothly.

- ◆ **Spring Break: March 11th—March 30th.**

- ◆ **Tuition & Preschool Payments**

TotSpot Preschool is a registered business and as such, we ask that you *please make your tuition payments payable to: TotSpot Preschool.*

Additionally, timely payments are appreciated.

We do not want to have to enforce late payment fees but will have to start doing so if late payments continue.

- ◆ **Punctuality**

Please be mindful of dropping off/picking up your children on time. On several occasions, we have been waiting 15-20 min. after class for some parents to arrive. The limited time which falls before/between classes is used for lunch breaks and material preparation for the following class/day.

- ◆ **School Folders/Water Bottles**

Please remember to send your child's folder (empty) with them each day. This helps us to ensure that the right projects/papers are going home with the right students. We are also going to start collecting folders/water bottles at our outdoor activity table just prior to class. This will cut down on congestion which can occur as kids settle in each day. *Water bottles should only contain water. We kindly ask that you avoid sending milk /juice as this can be messy should it spill and does not require refrigeration*

- ◆ **Snack Bag**

We'll now be sending home a Snack Bag a day prior to your snack day. Please remember to provide a healthy snack for all the students to enjoy. Ideas are provided on our snack calendar. Additionally, please be mindful that we have 12 students both in the A.M. & P.M.

Morning & Afternoon Class Field Trip—Tumbleweed Park, March 4th at 10a.m.

Meet us at the City Land area inside Playtopia at Tumbleweed Park for our “Things That Go” field trip. Children are encouraged to bring their bikes and/or scooters with helmets as we enjoy a day of outdoor fun. We will touch briefly on the concepts of bike safety/following rules and then allow our little ones to put their energy to good use! We invite you to decorate your bikes/scooters with streamers or balloons in advance of our field trip and as always... be sure to bring a sack lunch and wear your TotSpot Preschool T-Shirt.
